

## What is Seneca Shares?

Seneca Shares is a consortium of the five libraries in Seneca County. The libraries are linked electronically by a common automation system located at and supported by the Finger Lakes Library System in Ithaca. Although the libraries share a common automated system, each library is governed by its own Board of Trustees and individual library policies, loan periods and overdue charges.

## What is the Library Common Card?

Library patrons within Seneca County can use their one common card at any Seneca County library to:

- Gain immediate access to new books from all five Seneca County Libraries.
- View and search the PowerPac online card catalog, which shows the holdings of the entire Finger Lakes Library System.
- Renew and place reserves on items online.
- Obtain interlibrary loan requests rapidly and efficiently.
- Download digital audiobooks and eBooks to your computer and/or mp3 player.

## Free Electronic Resources

Log onto the internet, then go to the Finger Lakes Library System homepage ([www.flls.org](http://www.flls.org)) or link to it through your library website's homepage. Click on "Electronic Databases" and use your library card number to access the databases.

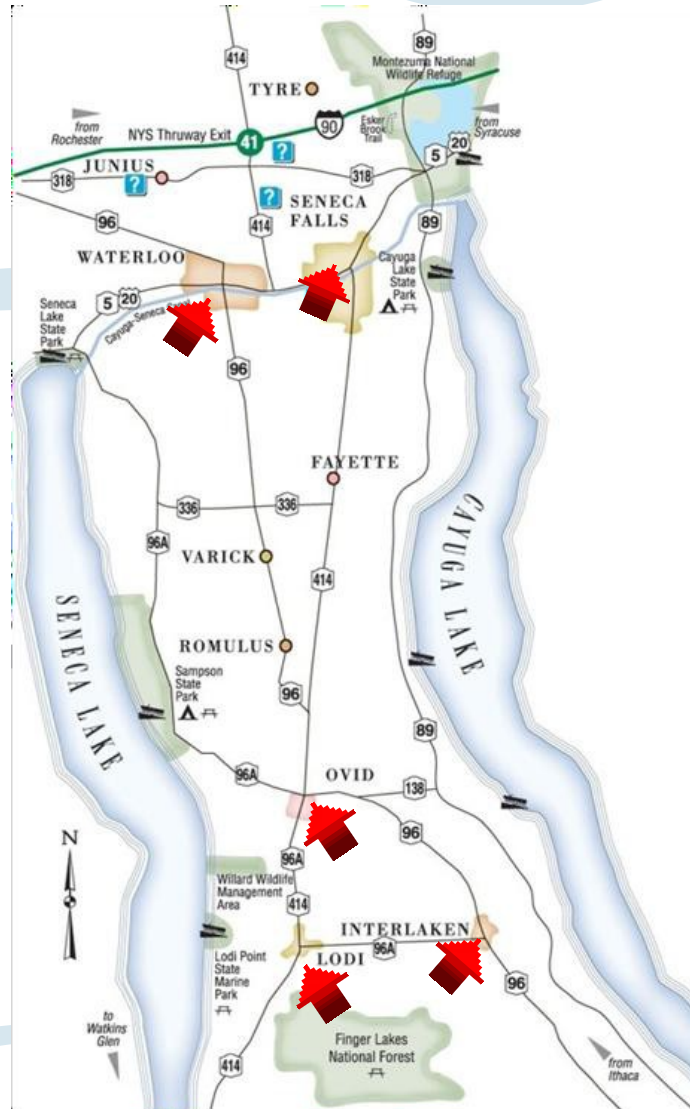
